**Review Summary**

**93 pts** – “A fragrant, pretty and understated Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignon with layers of violet, freshly sawn cedar and blackcurrant aromas wrapped up in understated, high quality oak. An energetic palate follows with lovely bright fruits, and al-dente tannins in support of a long, supple finish. Delicious already but also has the backbone and balance to enjoy over the medium term.”

**93 pts** – “Savoury start with pretty floral accents, straight-away it smells very elegant. Salty, umami texture, beautifully easy flowing with velvety soft tannins of cocoa powder plush feel, topped with orange rind, graphite tension and dried blood orange type of concentrated acidity. All well-balanced, judiciously measured. A bit of mint and moist dark earth and tobacco complexity, and more umami, really strong nori mouthfeel builds with time.”
