92 pts - “While there is no new oak, thankfully, it is aged in used French and American hogsheads for 16 months, so there are some smoky, woody nuances. Zin’s natural tannins need no extra bolstering from oak as it is, they are firm and decisive yet tethered to the dense fruit and savoury flavours. It’s rich and ripe yet not OTT as lots of acidity keeps it buoyant.”
