Review Summary

92 pts – “Medium ruby red hue. Blueberry, white pepper and dry herbs on the nose. Fresh blue and red fruits on entry, pepper spice notes with hints of dried herbs sitting underneath. Has a nice line to it, staying medium bodied and accentuating the lifted nature of the wine. Good length and tannins firm and dry the finish.”

92 pts – “There’s a certain power and richness to this, weightier than expected. It is flavoursome with dark fruits, kirsch, wood smoke, raspberry leaf, pepper, and florals come through, too. Full bodied and rich, the tannins are densely packed and expansive. The wine is aged in 2800L foudre so, while there shouldn’t be overt oak flavour, there is a varnishy character coming through and it detracts somewhat. Match to hearty fare.”
