



**2022 McHENRY HOHNEN
BDX
MALBEC / CABERNET PETIT / VERDOT**

Review Summary

95 pts – “The 2022 BDX comprises a blend of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. The bouquet is succulent and saturated in aroma, with cassis and raspberry, pink peppercorn, bramble, pencil shaving and nori. On the palate, the wine is dusty and svelte, and the tannins are pervasive, fine and chewy. A wonderful wine. Both savory and composed at this early stage, but it has plenty of chutzpah for the years ahead. Great! 13.5% alcohol, sealed under screw cap.”

94 pts – “A blend of Malbec (44%), Cabernet Sauvignon (39%) and Petit Verdot (18%). Only the Cabernet portion received new oak (20%). This is one of those wines where I decided I really liked the minute I tasted it. A very purple wine, to see and to taste. Plum, dark cherry, baking spice, nori, some rose oil perfume, but also has something of a grilled meat character. It’s medium to full-bodied, deep and fleshy, lots of flavour, hazelnut and plum, some ripe raspberry, balanced acidity, and a finish of excellent length, with ripe silty tannin to close. Very good.”
